The Letter to Smyrna--Taking Risks.

"You've Got Mail"

was a real thing for those seven churches in Revelation chapters 2 and 3. Imagine the day when the letter from the Apostle John, circulating among the churches, came to Smyrna. Perhaps they had heard there were some personal words from the Lord to each one of the churches. What words would He have for this suffering congregation, besieged by lies and slander, imprisonment and death?

Risk is an action that exposes you to the possibility of injury or loss. It might be small, it might be big . . . of injury or loss. The Christians at Smyrna had certainly taken risks in order to serve Christ. Now, they were suffering for it. "I know your tribulation and poverty" Jesus wrote in the letter. Then He added, "Do not fear what you are about to suffer." There was even more to come.

In part one of our message from Revelation 2:8-11 we will look at, 1) The Reality of Risks, 2) The Theology of Risks, 3) The Certainty of Risks.

Now a question for you. What have you risked or what would you risk in order to serve Christ? Could you risk your job, or even a career? How about your health? Relationships with family and friends?

Pastor and author John Piper wrote, "With staggering promises of everlasting life, Jesus unleashed a movement of radical, loving risk-
